So if there are multiple events with the same event code, if you just enter the code it should automatically pick the most recent event with the code.

If you want to specify one of the dupes, you can enter <code>:<password> in the "Event Code" field.

So if you had events:

SOFTBALL with password NCAA22 created on 1/1/22

SOFTBALL with password NCAA21 created on 1/1/21

SOFTBALL with password NCAA20 created on 1/1/20

You could just enter code SOFTBALL and it would import to the one created on 1/1/22

Or you could enter code:

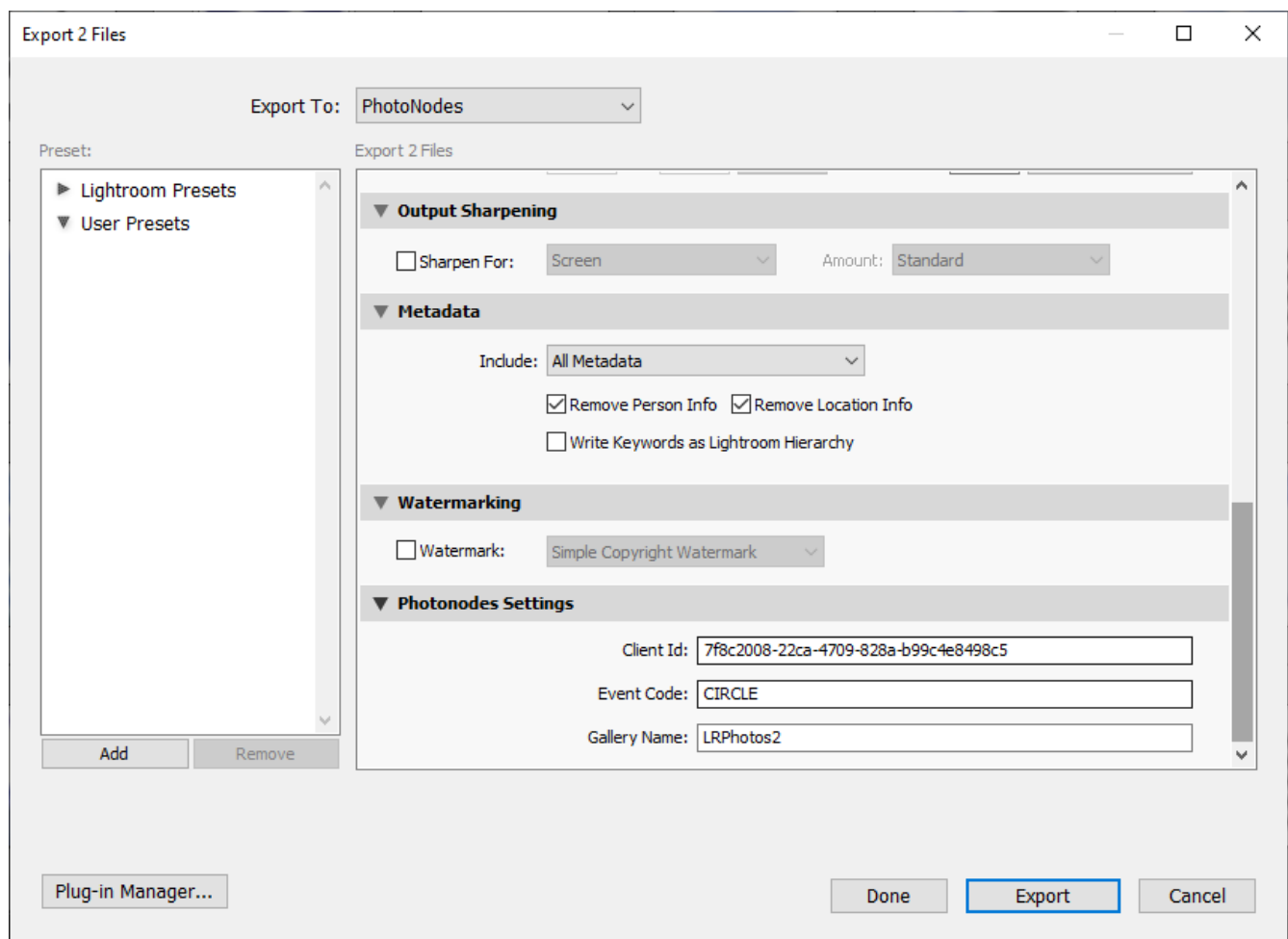
SOFTBALL:NCAA22 or SOFTBALL:NCAA21 or SOFTBALL:NCAA20

to distinguish between the three.

IOW, the code and password separated by a colon.

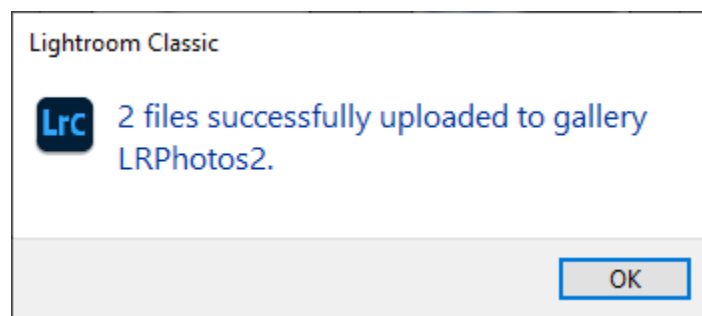
LR Plugin (beta) usage instructions.

1. Get the Client Id and Event Id for your event (see page 3).
2. Unzip and install the plugin from Plugin Manager.
3. Select some photos and File | Export like normal.

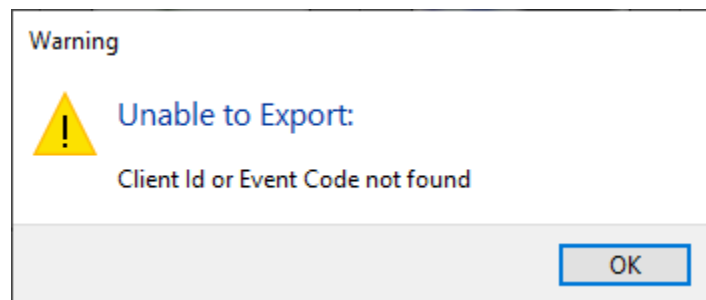


4. Select “Export To: PhotoNodes”.
5. Add the Client Id, Event Id, and Gallery Name in the settings (these will be saved).
6. Click Export.

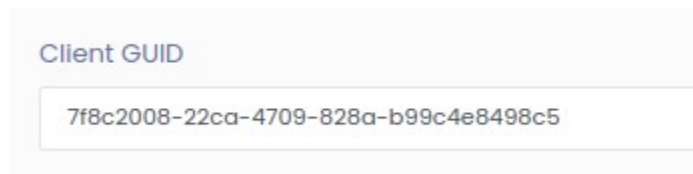

1. Getting the client id:

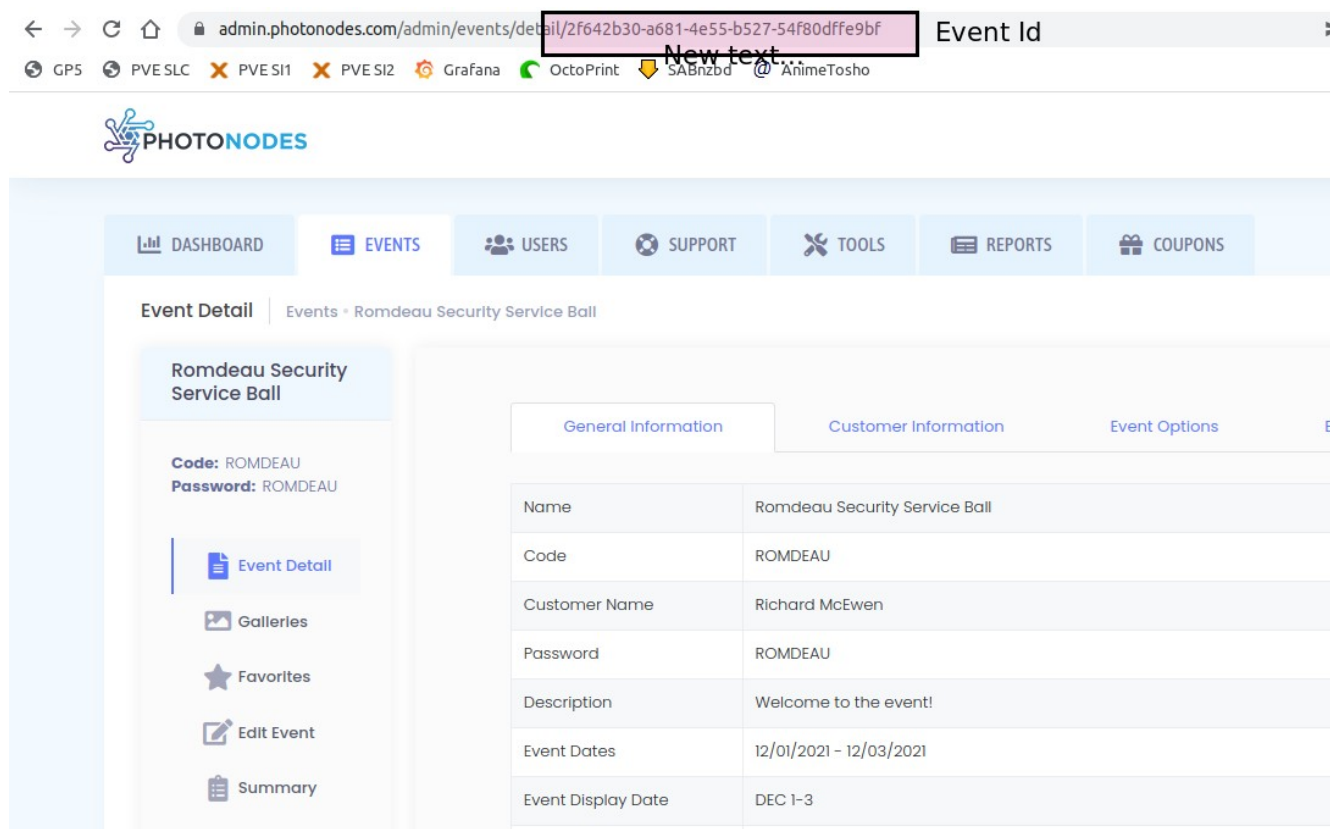
When logged in as a client, go to "Account Information".

The client id is in the top section:



2. Getting the event id (temporary):

Go to the Event Detail page and get the id from the url.

3. Gallery Name

The gallery name field can be a new or existing gallery name. If it doesn't exist, it will be created.
